### **Point of departures**

- Recommendation in the assessment report
- "ensure an appropriate regional balance and manageable size of the Steering Group."
- Priority during the Swedish chairmanship A more dynamic Forum
- enhance the working methods of the Steering Group
- ensure efficiency, flexibility and transparency in the work
- Complementarities between the Troika, the Steering Group and the Friends of the Forum.

 Request to SG members to reconfirm their interest to remain members and input for enhancing the working methods

# Result of Request to Steering Group members

Reconfirmed interest (29): Argentina, Australia, Bangladesh, Belgium, Canada, Ecuador, Egypt, France, Germany, Ghana, Greece, India, Indonesia, Israel, Kenya, Mauritius, Mexico, Morocco, the Netherlands, the Philippines, Portugal, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Thailand, Tunisia, Turkey, UAE and US.

Wish to step down (2): Japan and the UK

No answer (6): Brazil, Norway, Senegal, South Africa, South Korea, and Qatar.





### Discussions in the SG

- Work be developed based on the following principle:
  - i) aim to limit the size,
  - ii) clarify expectations of SG members,
  - iii) further define the roles and responsibilities,
  - iv) set up a clear process for how interest from new countries to become members
  - v) explore the possibility of a rotating membership.



### **ToR - Troika**

### Consists of current Chair, outgoing Chair and the incoming Chair

- assists the Chair-in-office
- discusses strategic and political issues
- makes recommendations to the SG and FoF





### ToR - SG

Membership – countries that have a demonstrated commitment and real engagement.

- Gives overall strategic direction
- considers and advises on policy issues
- provides advice
- periodically assesses the activities of the GFMD





## Proposed informal rotational system

Allow for new countries to join the SG

 Based on the confirmation from countries of willingness to remain SG members

Possibility once a year for rotation

Troika agrees on composition





### ToR - FoF

Open to all States that are members or observers of the UN as well as other GFMD observers.

- acts as a sounding board
- serves as a consultative body
- discusses and exchanges views on substantive issues
