Arriving in New York	New York's John F. Kennedy International Airport is located about 20 miles from midtown Manhattan, while Laguardia airport is about 10 miles from midtown Manhattan. Taxis are available directly outside the airport at the cost of approximately USD 50-55 from JFK, or USD 40-45 from Laguardia to midtown. Tip is not included. Time zone	Eastern Standard (GMT/UTC – 5:00 hour)	
Voltage and sockets	The electric current used is 120 V, 60 Hz. An adapter will be needed to use or recharge electric devices.	
Telephone country code	To call New York, you must first dial the country code +1. The local code for New York is 212. When placing international calls, dial 00 followed by the country and city codes (e.g. 001212telnumber).	
Tipping	Tipping is customary in many circumstances for service, especially at almost all sit-down restaurants which offer table service. Generally, the average tip is 15% - 20% of the total meal cost.
